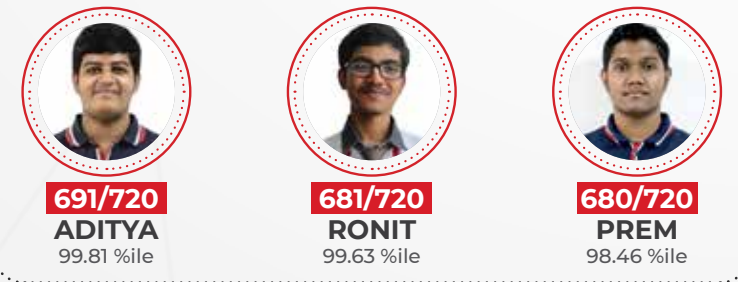

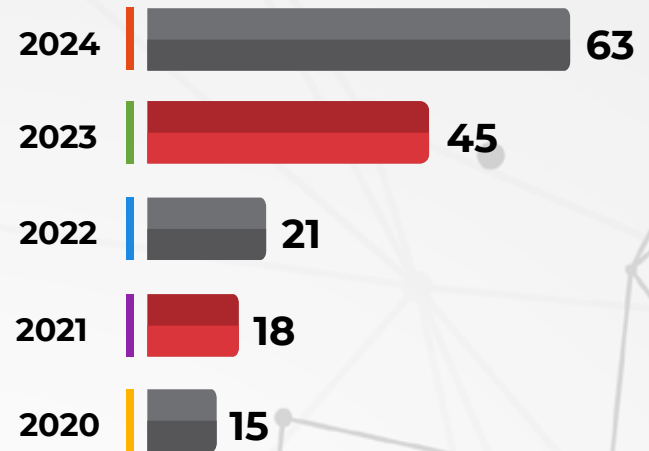

Restrictions

- Door to door service not provided
- Only in designated & pre-fixed stoppages - as decided by school (don't forget to check the bus stoppage list)
- Student pick-up and drop at designated stoppages only to ensure security. No requests for midway pick-up and drop are entertained
- Service provided and fees payable on a quarterly basis irrespective of mid-quarter application to avail or withdraw from the service.

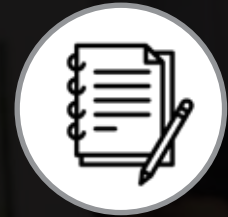

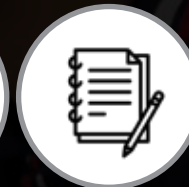

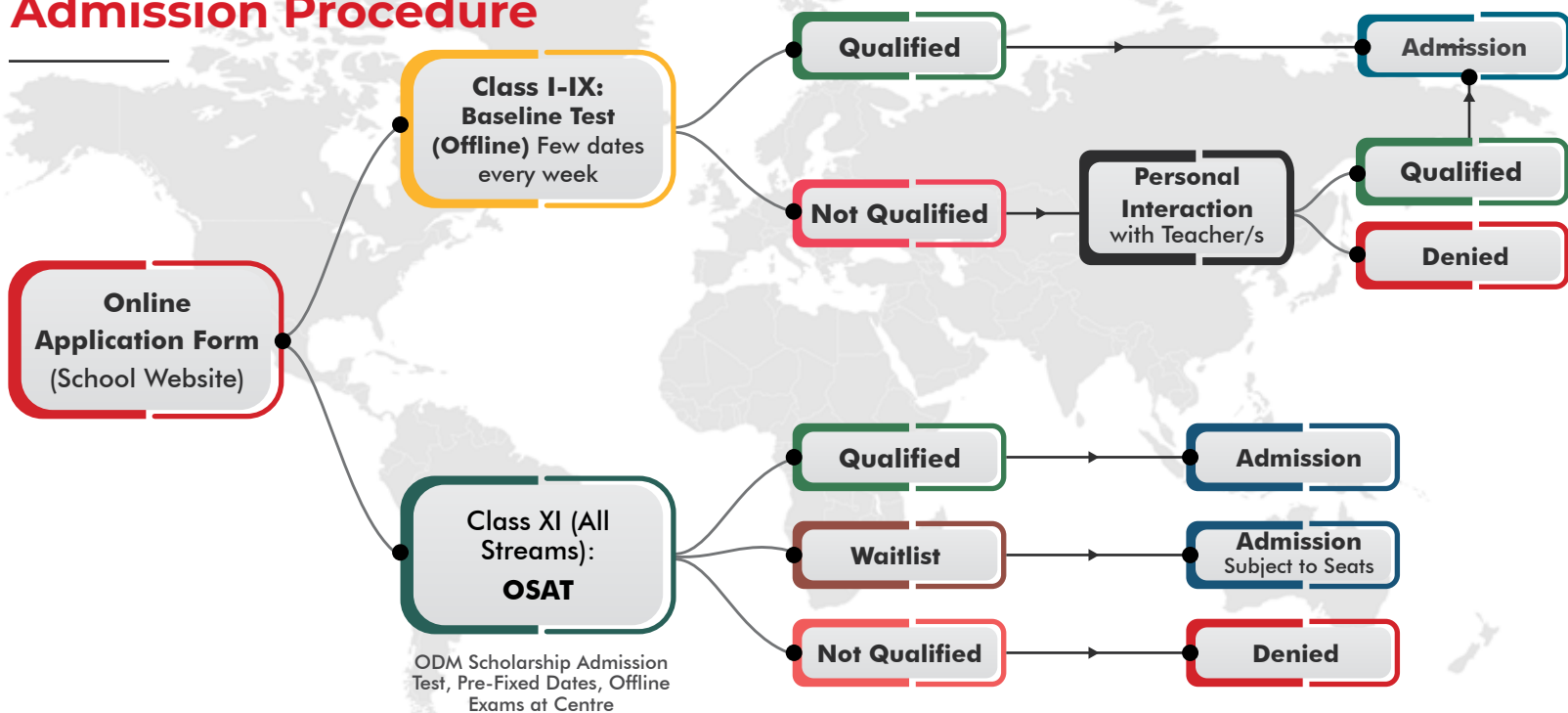

Important Terms & Conditions - About Fees

- i. Admission Fees or Provisional Admission Fees/Enrollment Fees - is non-refundable once admission/enrollment is done.
- ii. In case, school cancels admission on any grounds, school will refund the Admission/Provisional Admission Fees/ Enrollment Fees by deducting a specific charge as mentioned in the Terms & Condition Document.
- iii. School fees has to be paid on time as per installment/quarter plan.
- iv. School Fees will only be collected via our School App. No other payment mode such as Cash/Cheque/QR Code/DD/RTGS or NEFT will be accepted.
- v. Caution money is refundable only when the child is leaving the school. Caution money will be refunded, only after a written request is submitted with bank details.

Admission in Mid-Session/Change of Plans

- i. For any admission in mid-session, the admission fees has to be paid in full. The monthly fees of the entire month, has to be paid, in which admission is being taken irrespective of joining date in school (provided the classes have started).
- ii. Read the Terms & Condition document thoroughly, for all fees related calculation, in case of change of plans, withdrawals of scholarship students, etc.

Late Fines, Additional Charges

- i. There is a per-day penalty on payments of school & other fees, after due date. Please read the student handbook before beginning of the session, to know more about per-day late fines.
- ii. There will be fines & penalties for indiscipline activities by the students. These penalties will be clearly shared in the form a Discipline Handbook.

Additional Charges - for Residential Students

- i. Residential Students have to pay an additional INR 10,000 as imprest money for any small expenses of the students for round the year. The unutilised amount is refunded back.
- ii. Any student who falls sick, all the medical expenses (as per actuals) have to be borne by the parents.



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
